



FC Spokane Uniform Policy

By registering your player with FC Spokane a parent/guardian/player agrees to follow the standard set forth below.

Only FC Spokane approved uniforms and training kits are to be worn by FC Spokane teams. Diadora is currently the official brand of FC Spokane; we will maintain a 2-year uniform cycle. Players must purchase the designated style and may not wear obsolete styles unless expressly authorized by the FC Spokane Board.

Each FC Spokane team is required to coordinate the player purchasing of uniforms through the FC Spokane Board designated supplier. Teams are not allowed to modify the Club logo or designated training and game gear.

Players own their uniforms and may opt to sell or donate their uniform back to any FC Spokane member upon their departure from the club. Players are responsible for maintaining their FC Spokane uniform in good condition and must pay for replacement if lost or damaged.

While participating in games players are required to have their appropriate uniforms on, shirts tucked in, and socks pulled up. While participating in training players are required to have their appropriate practice kit on. Players must remember that they are representing FC Spokane while in their Club apparel and must act according to the FC Spokane Code of Conduct.

Each player must purchase the minimum training and game kits as designated by the Club.

U10 thru U11

- Black home jersey, White T-shirt (to be used as alternative jersey)
- Black Shorts
- Black Socks

U12 thru U19

- Black home jersey, White away jersey, Gold alternate jersey, Black long sleeve Jersey, 2 White Practice T-shirts
- Black shorts x1
- White shorts x1
- Black socks x1
- White socks x 1

Optional Uniform Items

- Black Warm Up Jacket
- Black Warm Up Pants
- Black backpack
- Practice ball
- Various FC Spokane T-shirt options

Each team must attend games with two different sets of jerseys to allow for change in the event of a color conflict with opposing teams.

Home Game Uniform

- Black Jersey
- Black Short
- Black Sock

Away Game Uniform

- White Jersey
- White Short
- White Sock

Training Kit

- White T-shirts to be worn at every practice
- Black Shorts to be worn at every practice

EQUIPMENT

While participating in training sessions, league, tournaments or friendly games, players must be equipped with shin guards. It is strongly suggested that players have at least two pairs of soccer shoes. Studs/Cleats for playing on grass and turf shoes for playing on field turf. Both pairs should be carried with the player in their soccer bag and should be properly cared for and kept clean.
